

# Instructions For Eid Aladha Arrangements

**Assalamu Alaikum Warahmatullahi Wabarakatuh**

The management committee in the mosque is pleased to congratulate all brothers and sisters on the blessed occasion of Eid Aladha. We pray that worship and good deeds are accepted from all and rewarded many folds and that this occasion revisits us while our Ummah is granted victory and success...Ameen. We would also be pleased to present you with some instructions and arrangements with regards to **Eid prayer** and related activities.

## **First: Eid Prayer**

There will only be one congregation for Eid prayer on **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2006** at 9.30am. To accommodate and facilitate for the Eid prayer the committee has decided the following:

1. Car park – the gate to the car park will be locked and microphones will be installed ready for the use of the car park as extra praying spaces in case of an over flow and the numbers of attendees is more than spaces provided. (we would advice latecomers to bring prayer mats just in case!)
2. Marquee- the marquee will be set up in the usual place in the garden of the mosque and it will be assigned for brothers only unless announced otherwise on the morning of Eid.
3. Women – women will be accommodated as usual in the balcony areas and the basement.
4. Men – men will pray as usual inside the mosque and the marquee that will be set up in the mosque's garden.
5. The management committee would like brothers and sisters to attend the prayers early and to follow the instructions given by the organising committees inside and outside the mosque to fully utilise all areas provided for prayer.

## **Second: Breakfast**

1. Breakfast will be served as usual after Eid prayer.
2. We ask our brothers and sisters to keep the mosque clean, control the children and cooperate with the organising committees.
3. Breakfast meal will be distributed for all attendees. The women section will serve breakfast in the marquee where there is more space to do so, Therefore we ask the brothers to leave the marquee straight after Eid prayer.

## **Third: Eid presents**

1. To avoid crowdness, the names of children have been distributed into 3 groups according to the surname mentioned in the application form
2. Every family should recognise the number allocated to them and to attend the collection point accordingly to receive a bag of gifts for all children named in the family.
3. Presents will only be given to those **attending Eid prayers and only to the person.**
4. To avoid embarrassment and disappointment we would like to make you aware that **presents cannot be exchanged and only given to the person who's name is mentioned on the application form**
5. Families who have not filled in an application form in advance will not receive presents **unless there were extra** ones available after the distribution process is completed. There will be an assigned collection point to fill in a latecomer application and to receive the present. Please avoid disturbing the main collection points if you're a latecomer!

## **Fourth: General notices**

1. Remember dear brothers and sisters that the mosque is yours so keep it clean and tidy.
2. Early attendance helps us to help and serve you.
3. We welcome any suggestions to be put in a positive way towards improving our services and contributing your time and effort for the success of different activities.
