- Your personal belongings and your personal safety are your responsibility and not that of the masjid or its committee.
- Adults and children, including infants, are not to enter the prayer area with their shoes on.
- Nappies must be changed in the nappy changing area of the ladies' toilets only.
- Parents are responsible to make sure children are not disruptive and observe proper cleanliness.
- All food or drink provided should be in accordance with Islamic teachings.
- Eating is permitted only in designated areas and **must** be cleaned immediately.
- No smoking allowed inside the building, car park or garden/perimeter of the masjid.
